Fellmonger's Company of Richmond – research notes etc

The Company of Fellmonger's of Richmond was one of the thirteen craft guilds of the town dating from the Middle Ages. Sometime following the Municipal Reform Act of 1835 the Fellmonger's Company was dissolved or became inactive. In 1980 the Company's record book dating from the years 1666 to 1820 was discovered and acquired. This prompted the re-founding of the Company in Richmond in 1981 as a non-aligned fellowship charity. This collection consists of ephemera relating to the re-founded Company in the late 20th century and research material by L.P.Wenham in preparation for the publication of his booklet '*Company of Fellmongers of Richmond, Yorkshire 1666-1820 A History*' privately published in 1982. A more detailed index is filed with the collection.
